

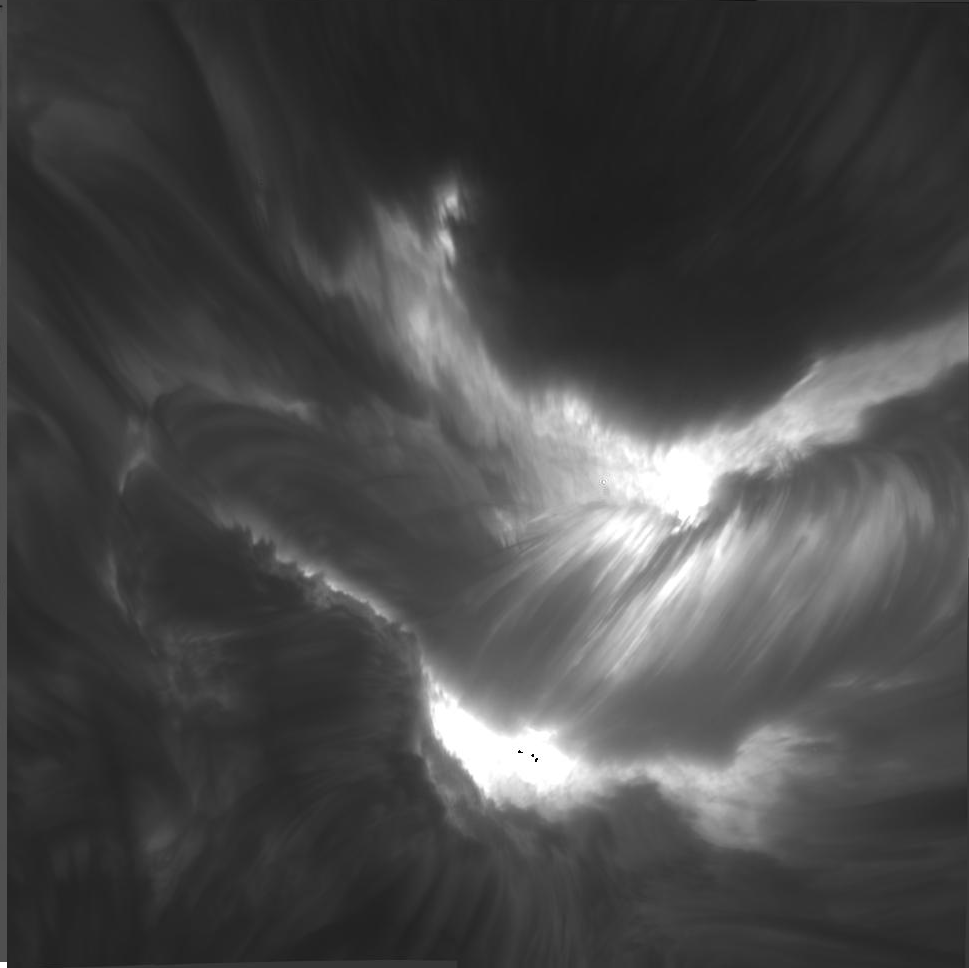
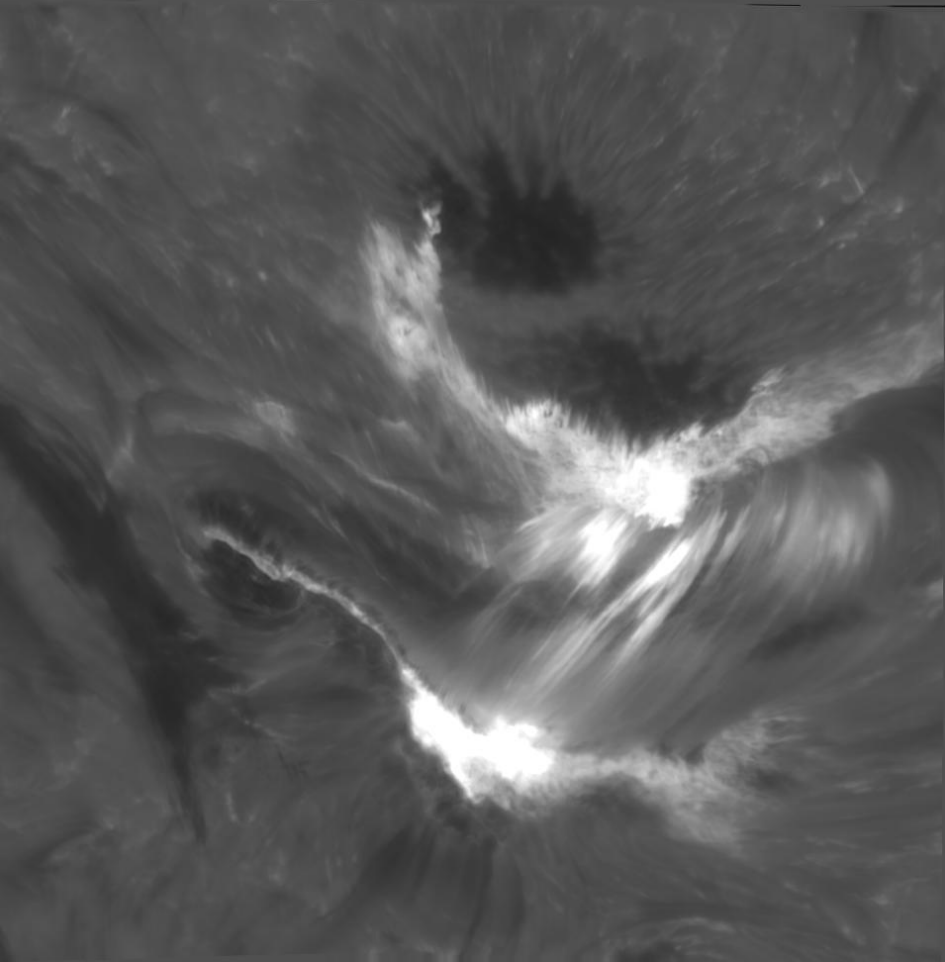
# Swedish Solar Telescope

- UK had access at the SST through SOLARNET (2013 – 2016)  
UK access to the SST was paid by the FP7
- UK access continued in 2017 & will continue in 2018  
Funding for 2017 provided by STFC, Armagh, QUB, Northumbria, Sheffield  
Funding for 2018 provided by STFC
- 19 days per year
- Imaging spectroscopy and spectropolarimetry  
(CHROMIS, CRISP, TRIPPEL)



# SST – UK access in 2017

- 12 proposals from 5 UK institutes
- Proposal externally evaluated (2) and placed in a ranked list
- Observations carried out in June and September 2017
  - Queue scheduling
  - Observers from: Armagh, Northumbria, Sheffield and QUB
- Acquired 70 Tbytes of data – Processing underway at QUB
- Imaging spectroscopy and spectropolarimetry  
(CHROMIS, CRISP, TRIPPEL)



- The September 2017 dataset includes 6 flares on NOAA 12673

# SST – UK access in 2018

- Call for proposals issued – Deadline 31<sup>st</sup> of January 2018

- Observations to take place between May & October 2018
- QUB will provide support – Request for DiRAC time
- SOLARNET II is likely to provide SST access in 2019 - 2023
